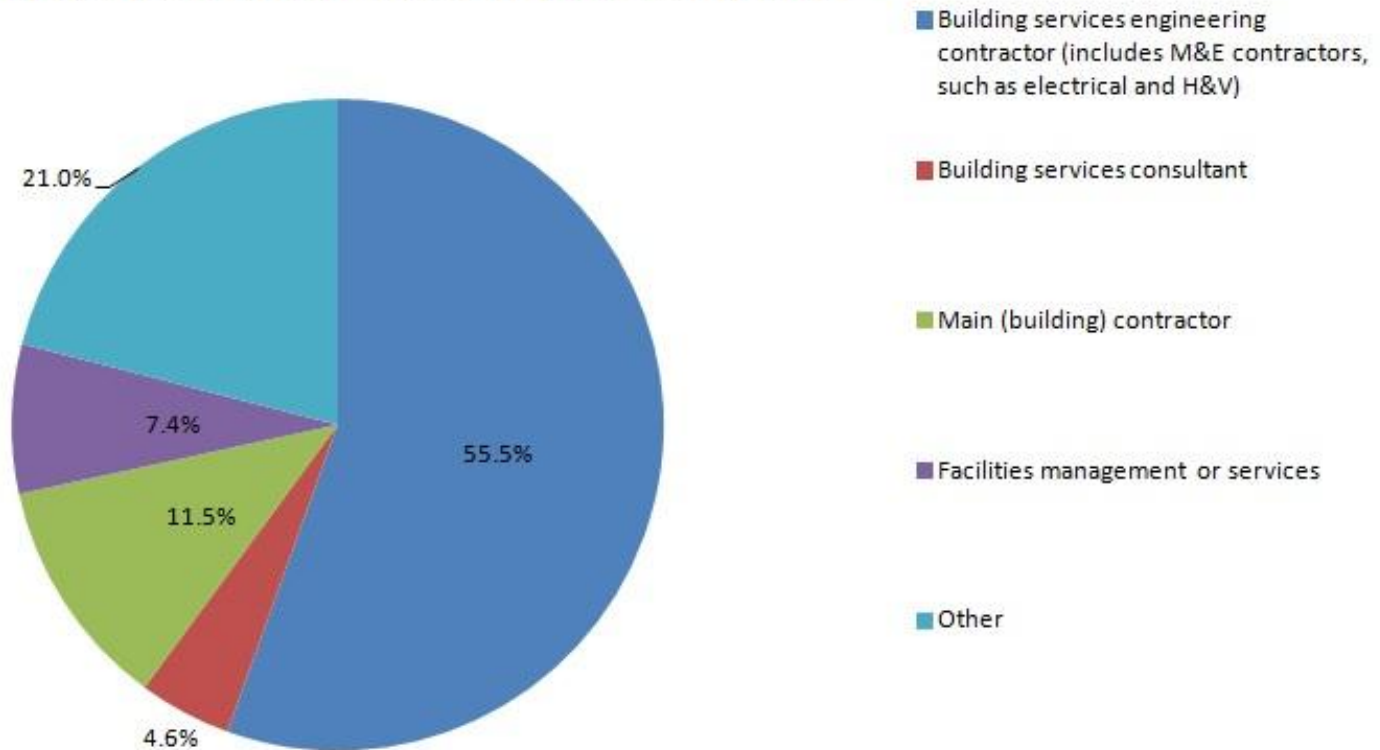

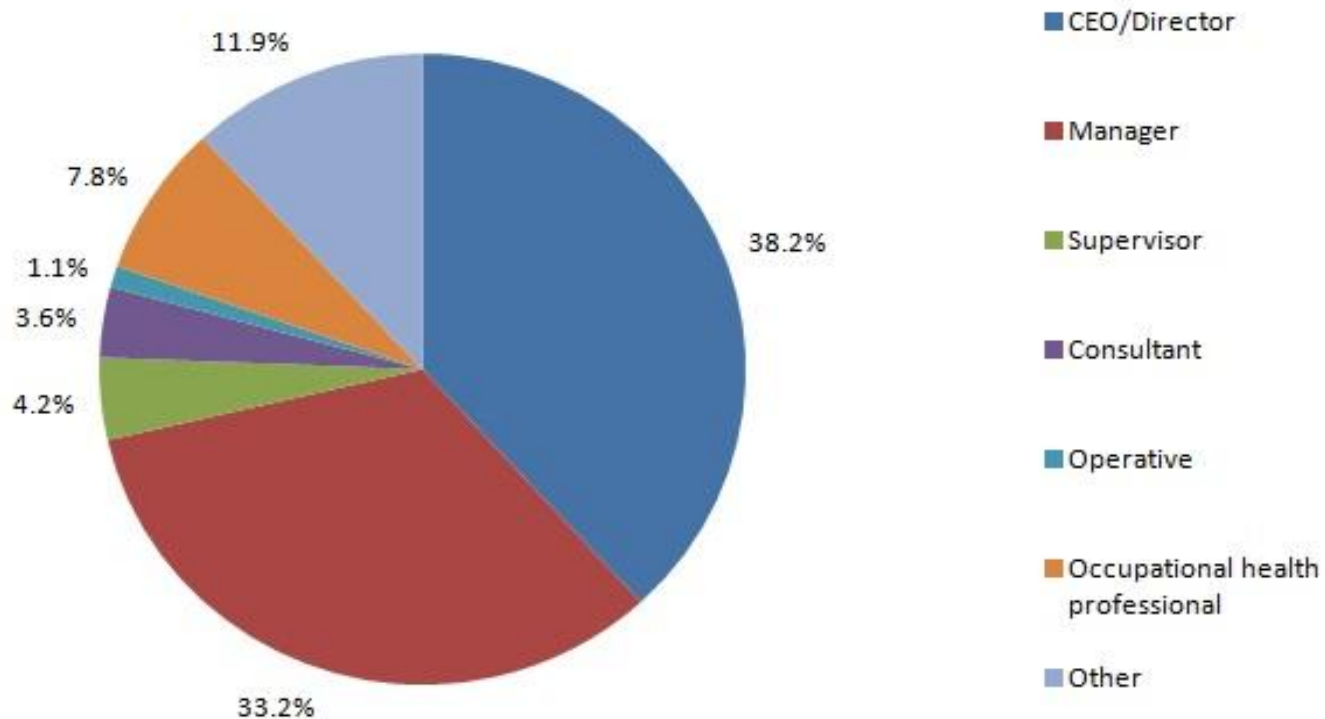

Q1 - What is the main function of your company?



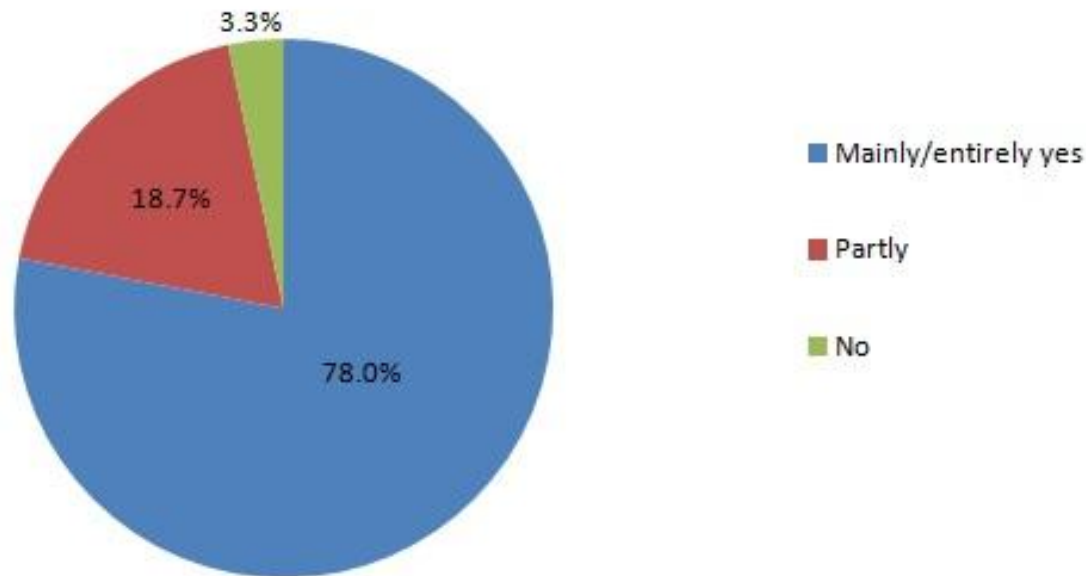

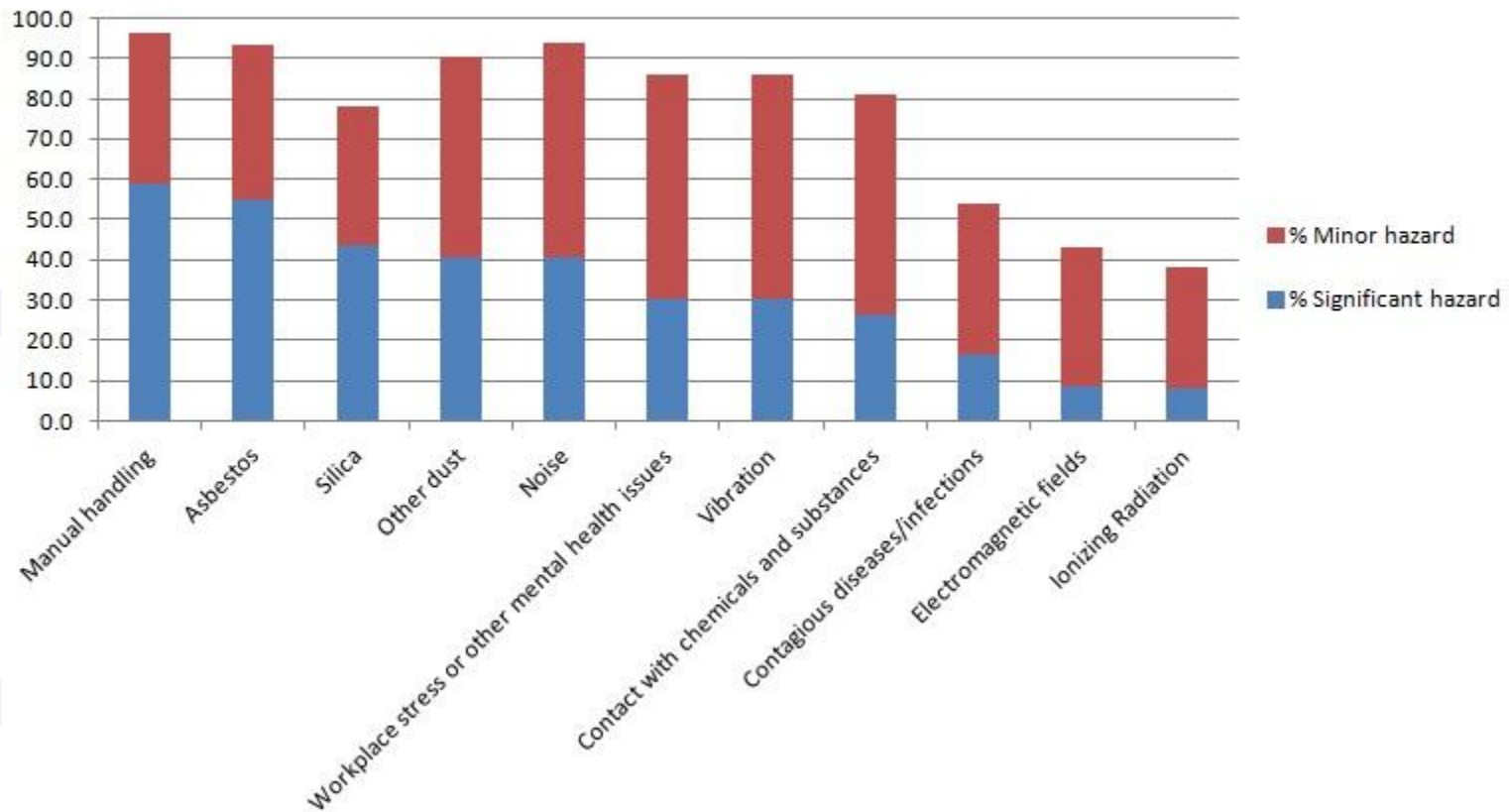
Q6 - Are you content with the working description of managing occupational health?

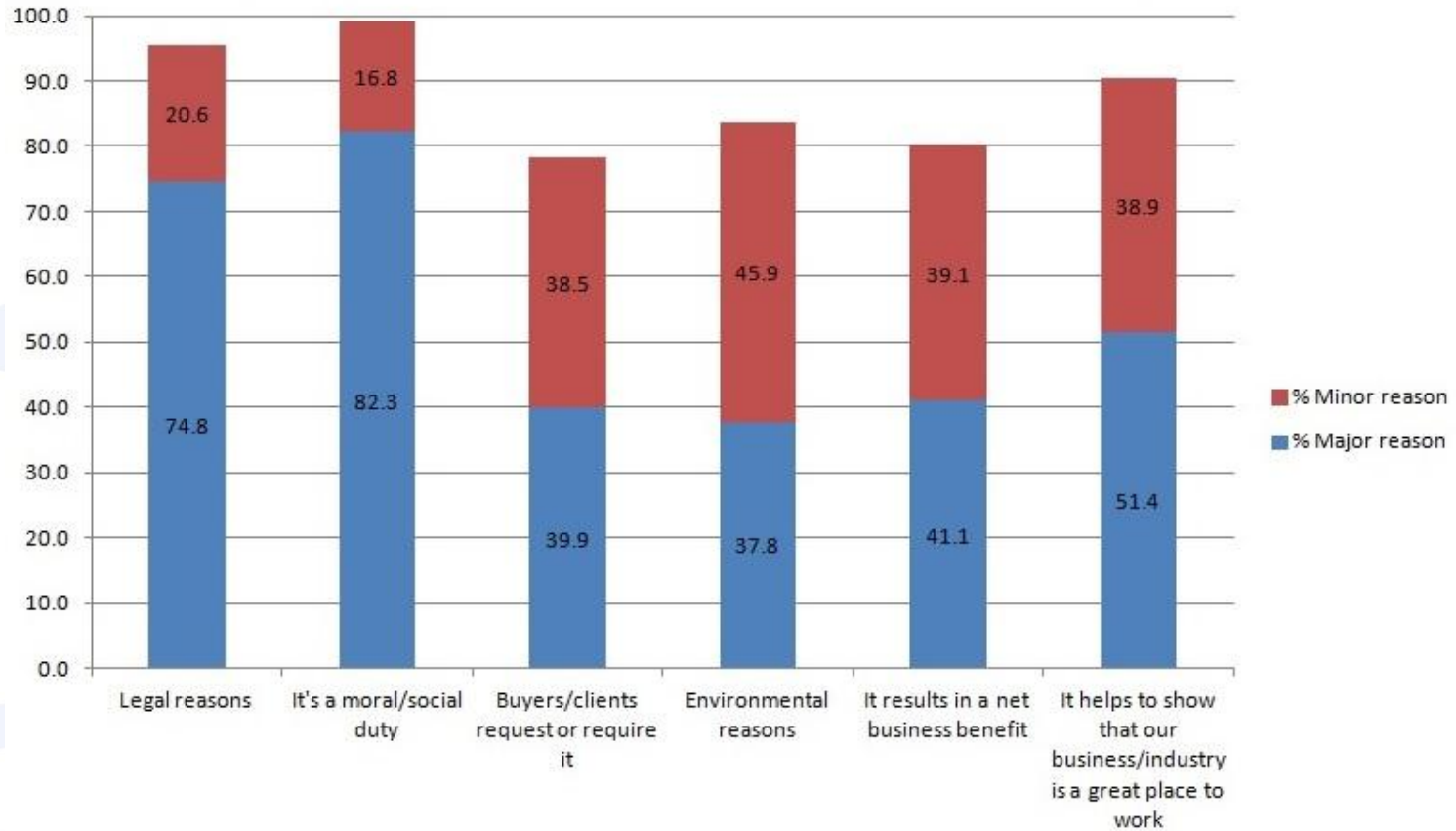

Q7 - Which of the following are OH hazards (rather than actual risks) to on-site employees in your company?



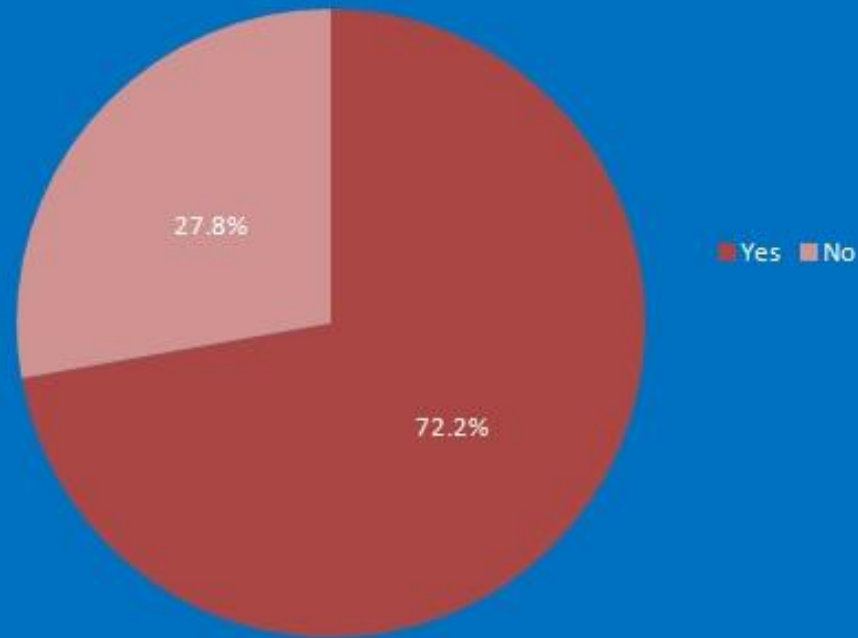

Q9 - What are your company's reasons for managing OH?



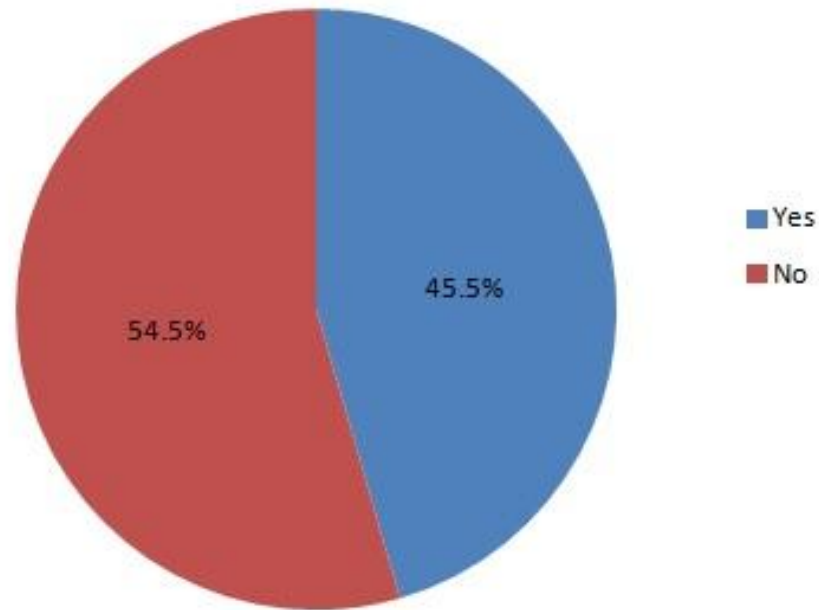

Q8 - Do you actively manage occupational health at work?



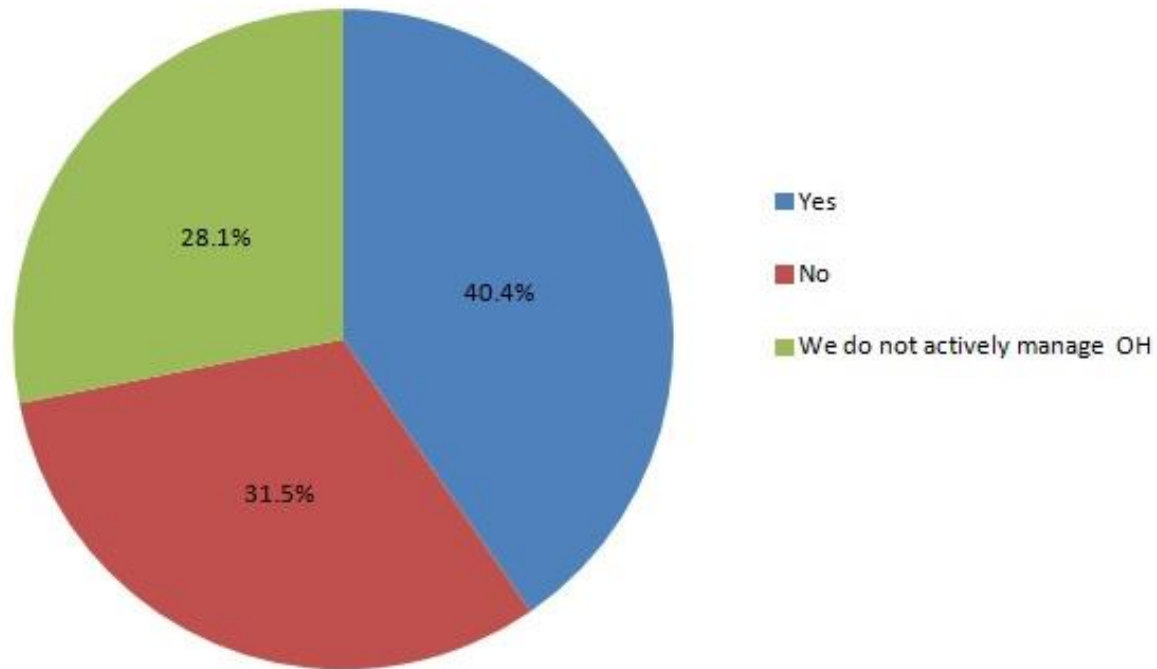

Q16 - Does your firm carry out any employee OH surveillance?



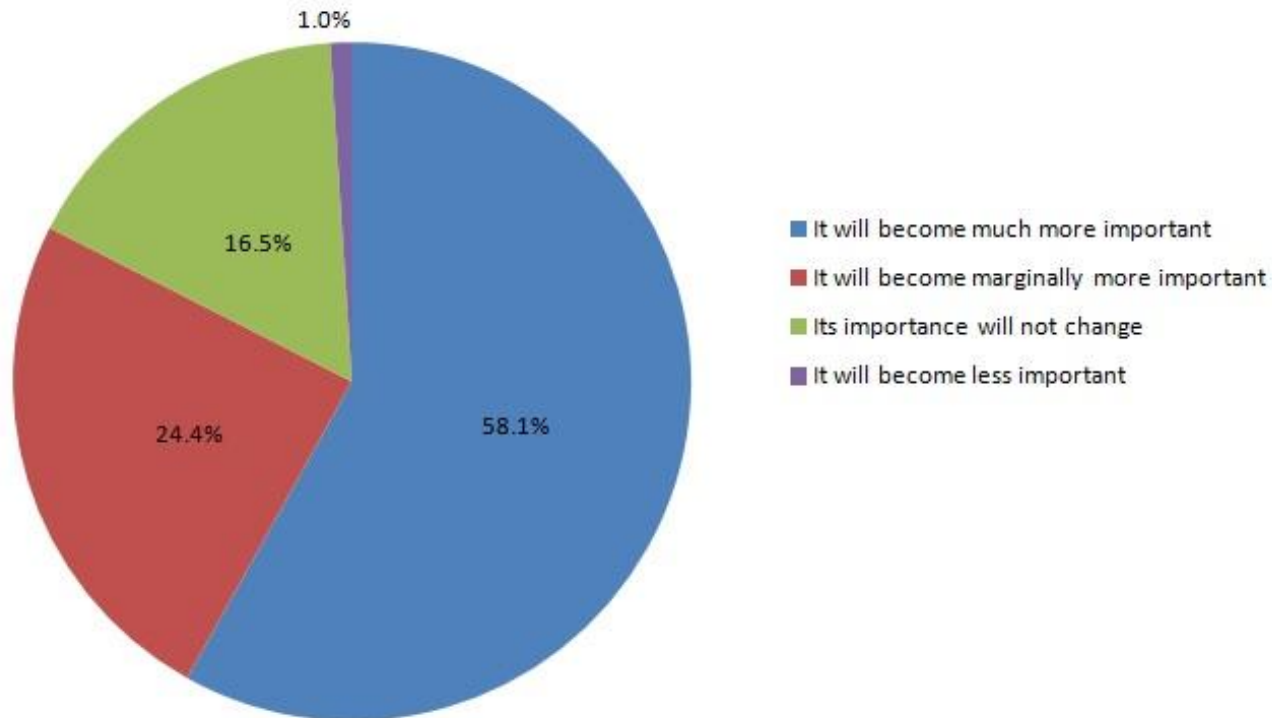

Q21 - Does your firm include managing occupational stress in its approach to active OH management?



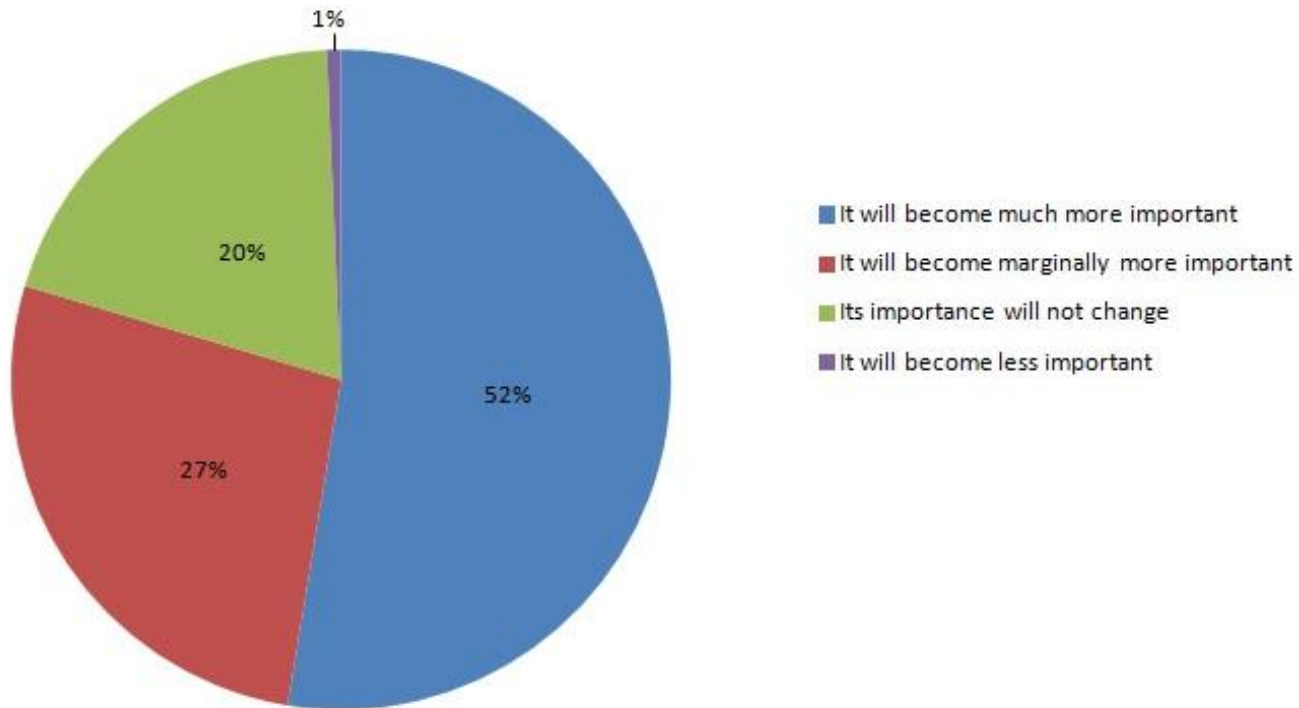
