Driving your association forward

ECA's committees and working groups keep Members at the centre of our initiatives—ensuring you decide how the association is run.

From our committees—Technical, Labour Relations, Skills, Business, Policy and Practice (BPP), and Fire & Security Association (FSA)—driving strategic direction for our key campaign areas: Business Resilience, a Safe Transition to Net Zero and Skills for the Future.

To our working groups and forums, from the Member Engagement Group (MEG) to the Growth Hub Group, our working groups give Members a real voice to determine the services we deliver and increase Member value.

Meanwhile, our Regional Executive Committees (RECs) empower Members to deliver regional technical seminars, business events and peer-to-peer support, ensuring they reflect local priorities and opportunities.



Improving our industry

This year, we have continued to influence and enhance the business environment through close involvement with Members and industry partners.

Key achievements include:

- For the first time, ECA Members have worked with Energy Networks Association on UK-wide guidance for electricity network operators. The new Engineering Recommendation G94 improves safety and clarity around multiple low voltage supplies, supporting a safe transition to net zero.
- ECA Members helped shape future fire and safety standards with revised British Standards in Fire detection and Alarm (BS 5839-1) and Emergency Lighting—Code of Practice (BS 5266).
- With active Member support, Electrotechnical Training and Careers Alliances (ETCAs) have expanded from Greater Manchester and Cheshire to the West Midlands, Kent & Medway and Cambridgeshire & Peterborough—with more in the pipeline for 2026!

From organisational decisions to national strategy, your influence powers meaningful progress where it matters most.



Influencing public policy

Campaigns led by Member insight delivered a lasting impact this year. Here's a snapshot of what we've achieved together...



Business Resilience

Most trade bodies talk about changing laws— ECA made it happen. In 2025, we drove eight major payment reforms, including:

- A landmark amendment to Payment Practices, securing the future of reporting regulations, closing loopholes, and increasing transparency.
- A pivotal late payment consultation, shaped by ECA and our Members, pushing for interest penalties, payment term caps, and long-overdue retention reform.



A Safe Transition to Net Zero

ECA built a strong coalition, raising national understanding of the vital role electricians play in a safe transition to net zero.

We kicked off the year with Electrifying Our Future, a Member-driven digital campaign launched at the House of Lords, spotlighting key barriers to electrification.

This was followed by the Blueprint for Electrification—a practical roadmap defined by electricians, who will be central to delivering the UK's net zero ambitions.



Skills for the Future

ECA's advocacy successfully led electrotechnical skills to become a Government priority.

Electricians are now recognised by Skills England as a high-demand occupation.

The Government has also launched the Construction Skills Mission Board (CSMB) to grow the built environment workforce. ECA is one of a handful of organisations appointed to advise the CSMB, ensuring Member views are represented.

In Wales, the Welsh Government's Green Skills Review included recommendations from ECA's Recharging Electrical Skills Charter—a clear sign our Members' voices are being heard.


