

Skills Bootcamps

Funded support for organisations with **employee upskilling** requirements

Skills Bootcamps are flexible training courses for adults aged 19 years and over. Organisations who are eligible to participate in Skills Bootcamps can get a significant proportion of their training costs funded, resulting in large cost savings.

They are a great way to upskill existing staff who may need to update or formalise knowledge or learn new specialist skills to develop in their role or progress in the organisation.

They can also be used to support employers to fill specific skills shortage vacancies, by upskilling potential new recruits or self-employed contractors.

Through Skills Bootcamps, employees can learn in-demand skills that businesses need to retain and secure contracts.



Eligibility:

Any organisation is eligible to apply for Skills Bootcamp funding, however, the delegates that are put forward for training must meet the below criteria.

Delegate requirements:

- 19+ before 31st August
- Live in England
- Have a company or personal postcode in North East Combined Authority areas of County Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside and Sunderland.

Delivery requirements:

- Minimum of 60 hours and up to a maximum of 16 weeks

Company commitment:

Employers who access courses for existing staff are required to make a minimal contribution towards the overall cost of training. The contribution is as follows:

- 0% contribution for unemployed or self employed delegates
 - 10% SME employer (1-249 employees) contribution towards existing employee training
 - 30% large employer (250 + employees) contribution towards existing employee training
- SME employer must have Company Registration Number (CRN)*

The next steps:

1. Speak to RelyOn to understand your needs and to discover whether your company is eligible for Skills Bootcamp funding.
2. Review our extensive list of courses (course list follows overleaf).
3. Select the Bootcamps you require (please ensure they meet the minimum 60 hours of training and can be delivered within 16 weeks).
4. Schedule courses with RelyOn – we require delegate name, date of birth and email address (to send joining instructions)
5. Pay the employer contribution - 10% for SME's and 30% for large companies. Please see the following page for amounts.
6. Delegate attends course and completes the assigned training.
7. Company provides letter 'outlining offer of an interview to delegate' and or letter 'outlining a job offer/additional responsibility to delegate'.
